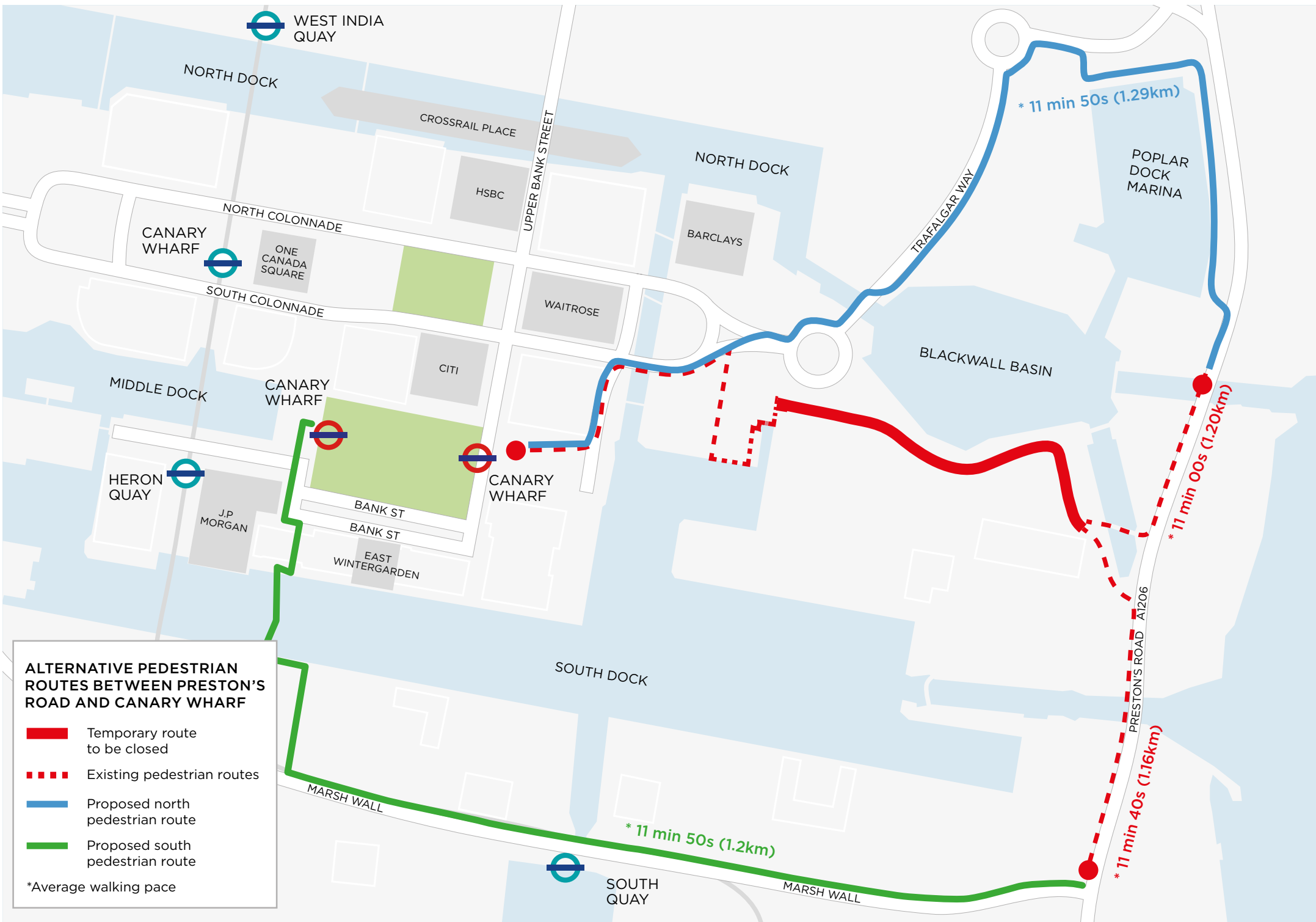


CANARY WHARF'S **NEW PHASE**

CLOSURE OF TEMPORARY PEDESTRIAN FOOTPATH DURING CONSTRUCTION

Please find details enclosed of the alternate pedestrian routes between Preston's Road and Canary Wharf to use when the temporary pedestrian access route through the construction site closes on 25/04/16.



We have reviewed the public safety aspects of continuing to operate the temporary pedestrian route through the New Phase which is now surrounded by complex and heavy construction operations in very close proximity.

There are currently piling works adjacent to Cartier Circle and immediately to the south of the temporary route. The piling works will be followed by the construction of a new road and utilities which will eventually link Cartier Circle to Preston's Road.

Later in the year will also see the commencement of the construction of buildings at the Preston's Road end of the site.

It is not possible to safely operate a pedestrian route through the site whilst these complex and heavy construction works are taking place.

Alternative pedestrian routes between Preston's Road and Canary Wharf, which are equivalent in distance, are shown on the map overleaf. Directional signage will also be displayed at key positions along these alternative routes.

We apologise if these changes cause you inconvenience however the safety of the public whilst major construction operations are taking place is our prime concern.
