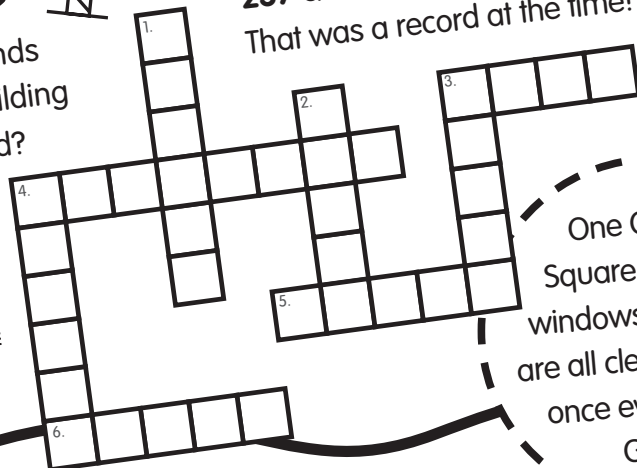
## Name game

Bricks	Glass	Wires

Answers: Reflecting badly: see right. Cranes - there are 8 cranes. Building blocks: 1 bricks, 2 steel, 3 (across) wood, 3 (down) wires, 4 (across) concrete, 4 (down) cement, 5 glass, 6 tiles

## Did you know?

Steam often rises off this tower's roof - people sometimes mistake it for smoke and call the fire brigade!
