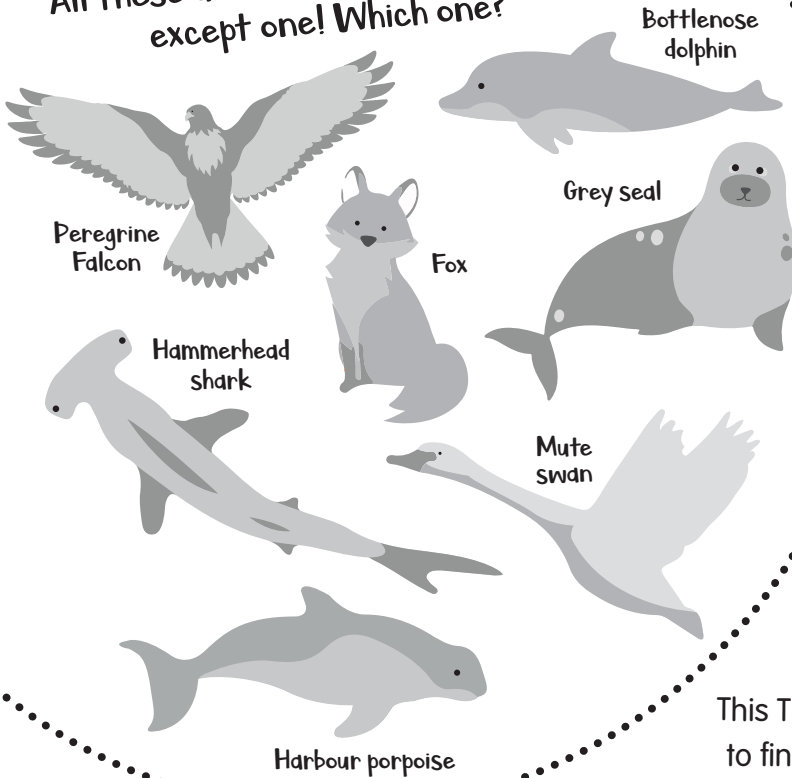
The River Thames and the docks are part of everyday life in the Isle of Dogs – and have been for hundreds of years

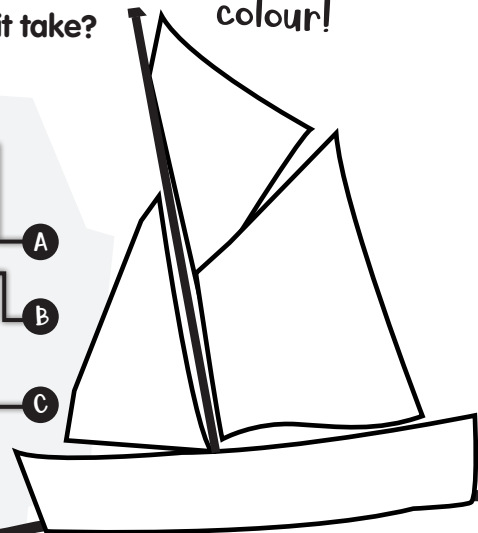
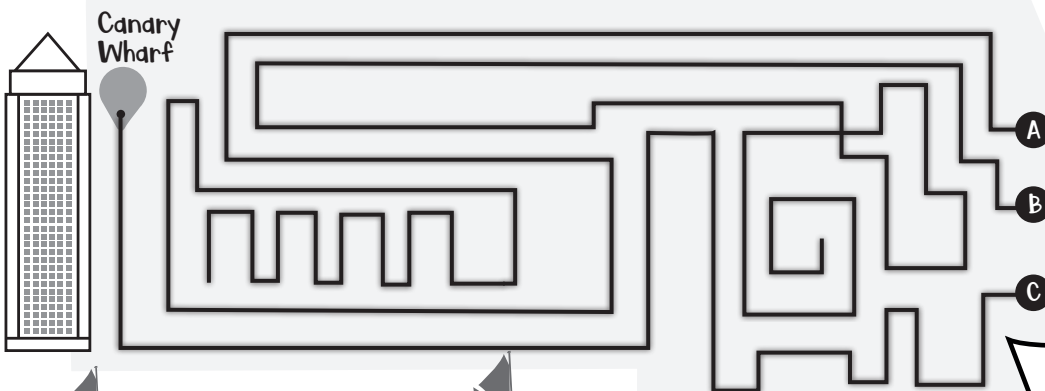
