Visit this stunning outdoor exhibition by renowned artist Helaine Blumenfeld OBE.

As well as being her largest solo exhibition to date, this is also an unrivalled opportunity to view Blumenfeld's work in the context of hard interior and exterior architecture. Her fusion of natural forms, both human and foliate, spiced with abstraction, are seen through a range of diverse works dating from 1974 to 2019.

Blumenfeld works in a range of media – marble from many locations in Europe and the Middle East, terracotta, wood and bronze, all of which she pushes to the limits of risk, teetering on the edge of impossibility, particularly in her carving.

HIDDEN GARDEN

Hidden Garden is a scientific representation of flora, using the medium of x-ray imaging to highlight the hidden architectural structures within the subjects. Each image will cover a theme including sustainability, habitat, pollinators and medicinal, each captioned explaining either the science, research or statistics behind the image.

Set against the apt backdrop of Crossrail Place Roof Garden, the blown-up images allow visitors to engage with nature on a more intimate level, allowing us to see just how fragile nature can be and how transparent it is that we should be acting against climate change. This piece will also feature as part of our Summer Lights programme.
