Launched on the summer solstice, Summer Lights celebrates the beauty of natural light, and the long summer days. Our outdoor areas will be transformed into sparkling, colourful and inviting spaces.

From a flock of bright birds soaring overhead in Jubilee Park, to colourful and kaleidoscopic interactive pieces at Wood Wharf, you will find 11 new artworks dotted around Canary Wharf to compliment the 6 permanent pieces

included on the trail, plus a spectacular exhibition of hand-blown glass in the Lobby of One Canada Square. These stunning installations come to life at sunrise as the daylight shines through and refracts, creating beautiful patterns, reflections and vibrant colours.
